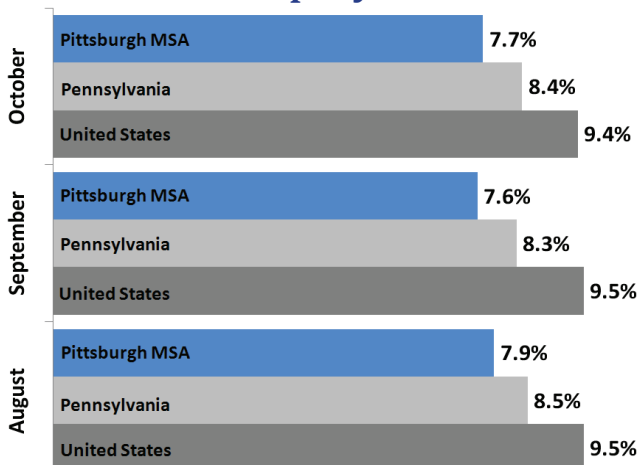

Unemployment Rate

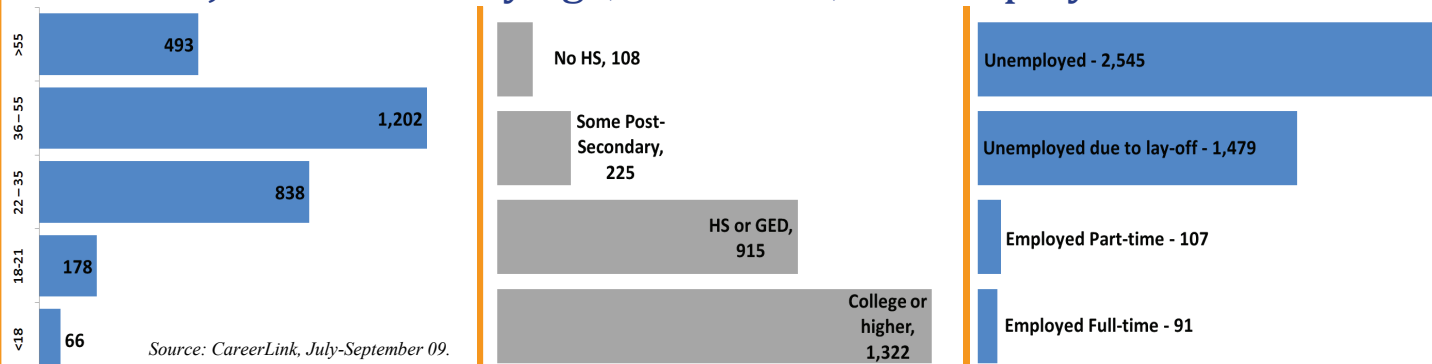
