



The above table shows percent decrease/increase in online job ads on a month over month/year over year basis. In March 2023, there were 33% fewer online job advertisements in all occupations compared to March 2022. March 2023 had **8.4% more online job ads** compared to Feb. 2023. Food Preparation and Serving Occupations had the largest YoY negative change in job ads with 48.8% fewer online job ads in March 2023 compared to March 2023. While job advertisements are down 33% between March 2023 and March 2022, there are still more job advertisements than unemployed workers in Allegheny County.
