The above table shows percent decrease/increase in online job ads on a month over month/year over year basis. In Nov. 2023, there were 13.1% fewer online job advertisements in all occupations compared to Nov. 2022. Nov. 2023 had a 7.1% decrease in online job ads compared to Oct. 2023. Computer and Mathematical occupations had the largest YoY negative change in job ads with 46.3% **fewer online job ads** in Nov. 2023 compared to Nov. 2022. While job advertisements are **down 13.1%** between Nov. 2023 and Nov. 2022, there are still more job advertisements than unemployed workers in Allegheny County.
